

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is entered into on 01/08/2026 between M/s. Neostruct Engineering LLP, having its registered office at Survey No 03, Next to Prakash Industrial Corporation, Shivani, Akola-444104, hereinafter referred to as the "Fabricator", and M/s. Sohum NDT Services, having its registered office at 17/A, Paradise Society, Sonegaon, Nagpur, Maharashtra, 440025, India, hereinafter referred to as the "Service Provider".

Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for collaboration whereby the Service Provider shall perform Non-Destructive Testing (NDT), welding inspection, and related quality assurance services for fabrication projects executed by the Fabricator.

Scope of Services

The Service Provider shall provide qualified personnel, calibrated equipment, and inspection services including:

- Ultrasonic Testing (UT)
- Radiographic Testing (RT)
- Magnetic Particle Testing (MT)
- Liquid Penetrant Testing (PT)
- Visual Testing (VT) and Weld Visual Inspection
- Inspection of Pressure Vessel and Piping Welds
- Review/Witnessing of WPS, PQR, WPQ and welding procedures, where applicable
- Preparation and submission of inspection reports and NDT records.

All inspections shall be carried out in accordance with applicable project specifications and relevant codes such as ASME Section V, ASME Section VIII, ASME B31.3, IBR, ISO 9712, SNT-TC-1A, AWS D1.1, and other client-specific requirements.

Responsibilities

The Fabricator shall provide safe access, inspection schedules, drawings, welding documents, and workpieces ready for inspection. The Service Provider shall deploy competent and certified personnel, maintain valid calibration of equipment, comply with all statutory safety requirements, and issue inspection reports within the agreed timeline.



Commercial Terms

Commercial terms including rates, mobilization, taxes, payment terms, and project-specific requirements shall be governed by separate Purchase Orders (PO), Work Orders (WO), or Service Agreements issued by the Fabricator.

Confidentiality

Both Parties shall maintain strict confidentiality of all technical, commercial, and project-related information exchanged under this MoU and shall not disclose such information without prior written consent, except where required by law.

Validity and Governing Law

This MoU shall remain valid for three (3) years from the date of execution unless terminated by either Party with 30 days' written notice. This MoU shall be governed by the laws of India, and any disputes shall first be resolved amicably; failing such resolution, they shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at Akola, Maharashtra.

This MoU records the mutual understanding of the Parties and serves as a framework for future business cooperation. Individual assignments shall be executed through separate Purchase Orders, Work Orders, or Service Agreements, which shall govern the specific commercial and technical requirements of each project.
